#### 6. Kyneton Botanic Gardens

#### 7. Malmsbury Botanic Gardens

Established in the 1850's the Malmsbury Botanic Gardens is central to Malmsbury off the Calder highway on the way from Melbourne to Bendigo. It is one of Victoria's earliest regional botanic gardens encompassing a wonderful collection of trees and shrubs along with a few surprises from its rich past. On the banks of the Coliban River, heritage gardens, mature trees, lake and fountain. View the magnificent 1860 Malmsbury Viaduct.

The Old Rectory is Kyneton's oldest home, commissioned by the Church of England in 1850. The Old Rectory is listed by the National Trust and the garden has featured on ABC television's "Dream Gardens" and Channel Nine's "Postcards". The garden was re-landscaped in the mid 1990's with its current design incorporating some earlier features (a 150 year old walnut tree and the external boundary hedges) and new internal hedging and planting.




